Mark has been working in the recreational fishing industry since he was a child, first as a dock-boy and eventually as manager of an Ocean City marina. Since 1987 his full time job has been charter boat captain and fishing guide. Mark also works as an outdoor writer and an instructor at Three B's Captain's School. He is the founder of the Ocean City Shark Tournament and has published in more than a dozen journals and magazines as well as being the author of "Modern Sharking" published in 2008.

Presently Mark is doing research off the Ocean City coast. He will wow us with pictures and video of his shark experiences and educate us about shark tagging and his research.

Thousands of fishermen and scientists have been tagging and releasing sharks to help researchers better understand and manage these incredible fish. Over the years recapture information has given scientists valuable data about shark migrations travel patterns, fishing pressure, mortality figures, growth rates and so much more.

Let's welcome Mark with a large turnout and make him feel at home. I just know this will be a great program. So come and enjoy the evening with us.

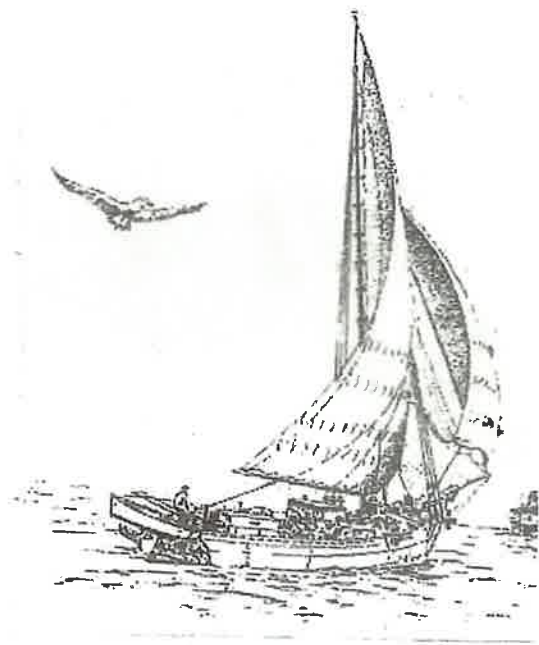

Tom Herrick, President of the OPA Board of Directors, has announced the revival of the temporarily moribund Marine Activities Advisory Committee and is actively seeking members. Your Boat Club was a founding Force in the formation of this Committee, and our members have traditionally taken an active role in its activities. We urge any interested members to pick up an application at the Administration Building. Fill it out and return to the Administration office for review.

We are hopeful that our members will consider submitting an application so as to continue the Boat Club's involvement in this important Committee.

For your information we have included the Official Function of the Committee.

3. **Functions.** In fulfilling its tasks, the Committee:

- a. assists the Board of Directors in formulating policies pertaining to marine matters;
- b. disseminates information on water and marine safety, Federal, State and local marine regulations, boating basics, launching of boats, trailer safety, rules of the road, and conduct to be used in parking and boat ramp areas;
- c. provides liaison to Federal, State and local agencies such as, but not necessarily limited to, the Corp of Engineers, Coastal Bays Watershed Commission, and Worcester County Shoreline Commission on water quality, environmental, fishing, crabbing, and navigational matters;
- d. conducts surveys of water depths, boating conditions, channel identification, safety needs, and related subjects;
- e. provides volunteer services where appropriate to support marine activities;
- f. reviews recommendations and concerns regarding marine facilities, programs, and activities; and
- g. performs other functions as directed or approved by the Board of Directors.
